1. Printed copy of the duly filled application. The application should be signed by the applicant at appropriate places.	<input type="checkbox"/>
2. 02 recent photographs of size 51mm x 51mm. application forms with photo of wrong specifications would be rejected.	<input type="checkbox"/>
3. Self-attested City Registration Certificate (Meldebescheinigung) of your current German address is mandatory for all types of document processing.	<input type="checkbox"/>
4. Evidence of Indian citizenship of parents or grandparents or great grandparents (Passport copy/Nativity Certificate). In cases parents or grandparents passport/Nativity certificates are not available, their birth certificate from India can be considered on case-to-case basis. (Applicable for people born before 1972)	<input type="checkbox"/>
5. Evidence of relationship as parents / grandparents / great grandparents if their Indian origin is claimed as basis for registration as OCI cardholder (Birth Certificate's)	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>6. Copy of the International version of Birth Certificate (duly apostilled/attested by the concerned government authority) where the names of both the parents are mentioned. Kindly note the following;</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• if the Birth Certificate issued in India, it should be apostilled/attested by CPV Division, Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi.</li><li>• if the Birth Certificate issued in Germany, it should be attested by the concerned Government Authority (Home Ministry, Polizeidirektion etc. ) and then by the concerned Indian Embassy/Consulate.</li><li>• If the Birth Certificate issued in a third country, it should be attested by the concerned Indian Embassy/Consulate in that country.</li><li>• Birth Certificate apostilled by the member countries of the Hague Convention are not required the further attestation from concerned Indian Embassy/Consulate.</li></ul>	<input type="checkbox"/>
7. Copy of the current foreign passport of the applicant.	<input type="checkbox"/>
8. Self-attested copies of the marriage certificate and spouse passport (In case married).	<input type="checkbox"/>
9. An undertaking that the applicant never held Indian passport.	<input type="checkbox"/>
